5. Meet the Scheide Pipe Organ - 4:00 PM Sunday, March 1, 2020

Our church has been given a wonderful treasure. We have recently celebrated the gift of a new pipe organ – the organ that was in the residence of a great humanitarian, philanthropist, and scholar of JS Bach – Dr. William H. Scheide. Thanks to the generosity of his widow, Mrs. Judith Sheide, the organ has been completely renovated and installed in the West Gallery of our Church.

Join us for a fun musical afternoon on March 1, 2020 at 4:00 PM as Dr. Bell and Pastor Tony present an informal introduction to our wonderful new musical instrument. The afternoon will include: – an explanation of the remarkable artistic design of the organ; – an overview of how it came to us; – what makes this organ unique; – a mini-recital by Dr. Bell and Pastor Tony; – everyone singing hymns with the new organ.

There will be three seating areas available: the **A section** will be in the loft, directly behind the organist. The section is limited to eight seats. **B section** will be in the loft as well, but on the side opposite the organist. The section is limited to 10 seats. **There will also be open seating in the sanctuary floor area**. Those seated here will be able to hear everything (and not need to climb the stairs!)

Due to the limited seating, those wishing to sit in the loft for this event should sign up on the paper on the bulletin board in the Sunday Café fellowship hallway as soon as possible. The event will start at 4:00 PM, and be about an hour in length.

6. Can You Help Us Feed The Hungry?

On Saturday, March 21, 2020, starting with a carpool from the church at 8 AM and ending at 12 noon, we can join with Methodists from all over our area to help prepare nonperishable food kits to feed the hungry.
